Track & Field Review

Dan Walsh had a great season, winning the English Schools 100m and going on to represent England in the under 20s squad in Cardiff.

In the Northern championships James Clark came second in the under 17 triple jump, jumping 12.32m, a personal best and club record.

One of our most promising young athletes, Zak Wimpenny, had an excellent 1^{st} season representing the club. He's current ranked 3^{rd} in the UK in the U13's 60metres and hopefully he will continue on to further success.



West Yorkshire League

The best performance in the West Yorkshire League came from Alicia Marriott who won the under 15 girls competition. Trophies were also won by Natalie McGuire (2^{nd} in the under 17 ladies) and Jack Kirk (3^{rd} in the under 20 Mens). Other high finishers were: Isabel White (6^{th} – under 11 girls), Jack Quinn (6^{th} - under 11 boys), Finlay Firth (3^{rd} – under 13 boys) and Zak Wimpenny (6^{th} – under 13 boys).

West Yorkshire Championships

Rhianna Finch (under 15), Finlay Firth (under 13) and Suzanne Pickersgill (Seniors) stole the show at the championships early in the month. Rhianna came 2^{nd} in the high jump and 3^{rd} in long jump. Finlay was 2^{nd} in the 80m and the long jump and 3^{rd} in the shot putt. Suzanne finished 1^{st} in the discus and shot and 2^{nd} in the hammer and javelin.

Other medal winners were Tiger Steel, (under 13) 2nd in the 80 m and Jack Kirk (under 20) 3rd in the long jump.

Northern League


